MODULE 1 — HERITAGE IDENTIFICATION

African heritage encompasses spiritual, cultural, financial, and genetic sovereignty.

Key pillars to protect: Language, Land Rights, Spiritual Practice, Economic Systems.

TM3 Framework: Each of the 9 Dimensions maps to a heritage domain.

MODULE 2 — DIGITAL HERITAGE PROTECTION

1. Document all sovereign knowledge in the FlameVault
2. Encrypt ancestral records using ZLA CosmoLock 007
3. Store cultural artifacts on IPFS for permanent decentralized access
4. Tag all heritage documents with Dimension 1 (Spiritual) and Dimension 6 (Social)
5. Create a digital inheritance plan for future generations

MODULE 3 — FINANCIAL HERITAGE DEFENSE

The greatest threat to heritage is financial dependency.

TM3 Solution: Build sovereign financial systems that cannot be seized.

FlameBank provides the economic backbone for heritage preservation.

BRICS payment rails ensure heritage funding flows free from Western control.
